

November 5 – Linda Lappe, CU Women's Basketball Coach

A three-time first team Academic All-Big 12 honoree, Lappe graduated from CU with her bachelor's degree in business administration in 2002. She is a native of Burlington, Iowa, where she had a stellar prep career. An honorable mention Street & Smith's All-American, she graduated from Winfield High School with prep records in career points, steals, steals in a season, steals in a game, career assists, season assists, single game assists and a 110-3 career record. Lappe, who is in her third year at CU, explained that she feels good about the coming year; the team has good leadership with juniors and seniors on the team and the freshmen have really improved. Her formula for success: get the right



players, empower them to be leaders, and instill pride and passion to restore the program with all players to graduate. CU went 21-14 this past season, advancing to the quarterfinals of the WNIT for a second year in a row.

November 12 – Isaias Braga, Boulder County Salvation Army
